

PRAXIS Australia: PRAXIS Plus+ Subscription Model Subscriber Terms of Service

Payment Terms

Automatic Annual Renewal

PRAXIS Plus+ subscriptions are auto-renewed 1 calendar year (365 days) from the original date of activation. By purchasing a PRAXIS Plus+ subscription (at any level – Tier 1, 2 or 3) you agree to an initial and **recurring annual subscription fee** at the then-current annual subscription rate, and you accept responsibility for these charges until you successfully cancel your subscription.

For example, if an account was activated on the 3rd March 2021, the account owner would be automatically billed on the 3rd March 2022 for the next year's services at the then-current subscription rate unless they cancelled their subscription before the auto-renewal date (in this case the 3rd March 2022).

You can cancel your PRAXIS Plus+ subscription at any time, in accordance with the [PRAXIS Plus+ Cancellation Policy](#) included in this document. This policy also explains the steps involved in cancelling your account. No refunds will be offered and transfer of subscription to another user is also prohibited.

Restrictions on Use

General Restrictions

- Services and benefits made accessible through the PRAXIS Plus+ Subscription Model are intended for the **personal use of paying subscribers** and **may not be distributed to non-paying third-party users**.
- In addition, no part of any media, print or other proprietary content including recordings of online sessions offered through PRAXIS Plus+ may be copied, reproduced, shared, distributed or transmitted online or offline in any form or by any means without the express permission of PRAXIS Australia Ltd.

Restrictions for Specific Benefits

- 5% discount on all PRAXIS fee paying services (unlimited use for the 12-month subscription period)

- Subscriptions including the abovementioned benefit entitle the paying user to a 5% discount on any and every PRAXIS fee paying service purchased **by that paying user and no other** within the 12-month active subscription period.
 - The sharing of discount codes or login credentials with non-paying users to obtain additional, non-inclusive cost concessions is strictly prohibited and will be monitored and reported by PRAXIS staff.

PRAXIS Plus+ Cancellation Policy

Termination of Subscription

Annual subscription fees for PRAXIS Plus+ are non-refundable. You may cancel your PRAXIS Plus+ subscription at any time after you are billed for the then-current year and before you are billed for the next year.

Subscriptions can be cancelled from within the 'Manage My Account' section of the PRAXIS Plus+ subscriber environment. Manage My Account is accessed via the PRAXIS Plus+ drop-down menu located on the main navigation bar of the PRAXIS website.

Within Manage My Account, navigate to the 'Subscriptions' tab, immediately to the right of the 'Edit details' tab. The far-right column of this tab contains the buttons 'Update', 'Change Plan' and 'Cancel'. Click on the Cancel button and follow the on-screen prompts to finalise the cancellation of your account.

You should receive an email (sent to the account sign-up address) confirming the cessation of automatic payments soon after completing the cancellation process.

Termination Confirmation

PRAXIS will issue correspondence confirming effective subscription cancellation to the email associated with your account within 48 hours of its submission (during normal business hours). Please reach out to PRAXIS staff at the contact details listed below if you do not receive termination confirmation within the given timeframe as there may be issues with processing your request.
