The PRAXIS Australia Clinical Trials Coordinator (CTC) Internship Program aims to equip CTC's with the skills needed in Australia's post-pandemic clinical trials landscape through leading-edge training.

This selective program is aimed at Health Science graduates, early-career Clinical Trial Coordinators, and other health professionals seeking entry into the clinical trials sector as a CTC.

The program will commence in January 2023 and be delivered by the end of 2023, and requires a time commitment of 3 days per week.
